Questions are not listed in order of difficulty. All solutions have a connection to, or relate to, the Pascal theme. The test is a tribute to Blaise Pascal's life and his towering intellect. It highlights his interests and accomplishments, the milieu in which he lived and interacted, along with his far-reaching legacy, modern adaptations of his work, and his influence over time. Additionally, the clues and questions involve a smattering of word fun, along with delving into word structure and morphology that remains consistent with the Pascal theme. He is renowned globally across many language backgrounds and cultural settings.

For each question, the number of required letters is provided for your one-word answer. Use of references, including the internet, is allowed. Collaborating with others or sharing answers is prohibited. There is no time restriction and two submissions are allowed. No submission fee is required.

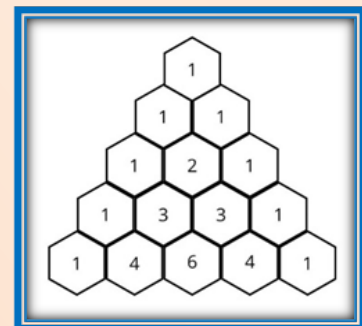
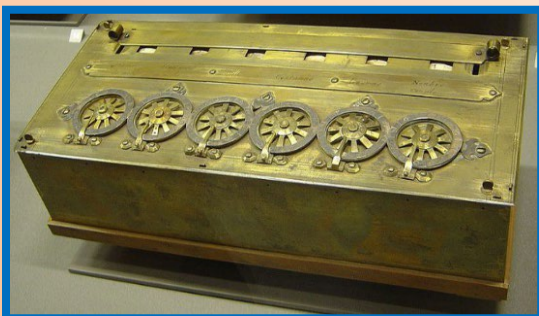
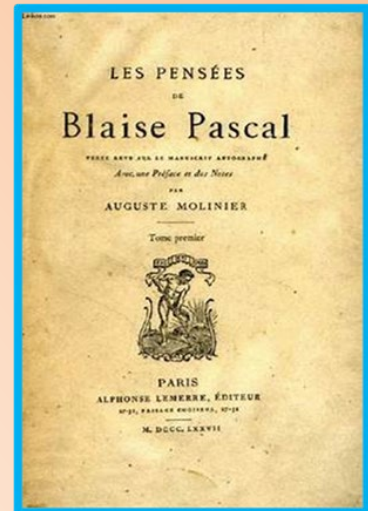
